- Bhavesh Natha leads the vascular clinical team, providing cutting-edge endovascular and open surgery, as well as the expertise for vascular access work. He will cover both Kingsbury and Vincent Pallotti vascular.
- Philip Matley has increasingly been asked to take over a surgical leadership role nationally, and will be devoting increasing time to his role as Chairman of Surgicom, and within the multi-disciplinary South African Private Practitioners Forum (SAPPF).
